

Coach Steve Smith is beginning his thirty-third year as Head Coach & Athletic Director of the Oak Hill Academy Warriors. Smith first came to Oak Hill in 1983 as an assistant, later taking the head coaching position at the beginning of the 1985 season. During his career he now has an overall record of more than 1000 wins. He has maintained a winning percentage of 94.2% while playing the top teams across the country. Coach Smith's winning percentage is the highest in high school basketball history.



Smith has recorded four 40-win seasons (2005-06, 2006-07, 2008-09, 2011-12), and boasts a 65-game win streak (2000-2002). He was named National High School Coach of the Year by USA TODAY in 1994, 1999, 2004 and 2012 and is the only coach to have received this

honor four times. Also, Coach Smith was honored in 2008-09 and 2011-12 to be named the Naismith High School Coach of the Year by the Atlanta Tip-Off Club. His teams have claimed eight mythical National Championships (1993, 1994, 1999, 2001, 2004, 2005, 2007, 2012), and they have been runners-up six times (1990, 1992, 2000, 2002, 2006, 2009).

In Smith's 33 years at Oak Hill, 32 of his players have been selected as McDonald's All Americans—more than any other high school in the country. Smith has also coached an impressive 27 NBA Draftees and over 150 Division I athletes. He has served as head coach for the McDonald's Capitol Classic (1989), the Jordan Classic (2002, 2007), the Dapper Dan Roundball Classic (1991, 1994), the Kentucky Derby Festival (1991, 1994, 1996, 2000, 2003, 2011), the NIKE-Chicago Sun Times All-Star Classic (1993), the Magic Johnson Roundball Classic (1994), and the McDonald's All-American Game in St. Louis (1995), and the Nike World Global Challenge in Portland, Oregon (2007). Coach Smith has spoken at numerous basketball clinics and camps across the United States, as well as in France, Italy, The Netherlands and Cyprus.

Smith is a 1977 graduate of Asbury College in Wilmore, Kentucky and received his M.S. from Eastern Kentucky University, Richmond, Kentucky. He has two children with his wife Lisa McBride—Stephanie, who currently resides in Nashville with husband Justin Atkins, and Sean, who lives in Charlotte, North Carolina with his wife Sarah.
